DIRECTIONS & PARKING:	<u>Traveling North/South on I-29</u> : Take Exit 140/Turn Right onto Demers Ave./Turn Left onto N 42nd St./Turn Right onto University Ave./Continue on University Ave./The Memorial Union and Parking Ramp will be on your right-hand side. <u>Traveling East/West on Hwy 2</u> : Travel on Hwy 2 and enter Grand Forks/Continue along Gateway Dr. and turn South onto Columbia Rd./Continue on Columbia Rd. until 2nd Ave. N and take a Right/The Memorial Union and Parking Ramp are on the right-hand side.		
	Exhibitors may park in the parking ramp on the east side of the Memorial Union. You will be able to park in Levels 4 and 5 of the parking ramp. After parking, follow the instructions below to help navigate yourself to the Memorial Union. Signage will also be provided to direct you to the Ballrooms. Navigation: Upon entering the stairwell area, take the elevator down to the first floor. Walk out the west end of the parking ramp. Head west and walk past the 'University of North Dakota' archway. Keep walking until the building indent and enter the doors nearest you, which will help you avoid walking through the food court. Upon entering, the grand staircase will be in front of you and the elevators will be off to the right from the grand staircase along the wall.

FAIR STRUCTURE & SET-UP: The fair will be divided into two shifts to try and prevent one shift from having too many students to accommodate for the space. At the beginning of each shift, students will have the opportunity to sit in on a 15-minute session to learn more about two-year or four-year academic careers. The session is designed to help students learn more about their academic career, the education needed for their career(s) of interest, and to come up with constructive questions to ask when they enter the college fair. The presenters are instructed to be impartial to all industries and institutions when outlining the academic requirements for professions. After the 15 minutes are up, the students will participate in the college fair. Students who do not wish to participate in the session will enter the fair upon arriving. There



will be a short gap between the first and second shifts to allow exhibitors to grab a snack or use the restroom.

Tables will NOT be assigned and will be available for set-up beginning at 8:30 a.m.
